The Federation is working with the Superintendent and the School Board to try and recover the \$2500 from last year's MFP money for all certified personnel, and a \$2000 pay raise for all support workers.

However, this does not happen overnight because there is a process that must be followed

The Board Voted To Pay All Employees Early on Friday, October 23rd.

Two petitions were circulated for signatures to get all employees a pay raise, one for the certified employees and one

for the support workers. The Federation **Thanks You** for signing the petitions. If you did not get an opportunity to sign the petitions, please stop by the office, or ask your building representative about the petition. As we move forward with the pay raise campaign, the petitions will be presented to the school board. I would also like to thank the principals and supervisors for their warm welcomes during our school visits. We will keep you updated on the raises.

Why A Raise and Not A Bonus

The Federation has received calls and has heard rumors about the pay raises. Let us clear up what's being said. First, the certified employees' raises will come from the MFP growth money that was due to them last year. These funds can only be spent on teacher pay raises. Second, the November sales tax check that all employees get will not be touched. It will remain as is, a bonus check.

The raise for the support employees is new monies that they have never received. We are trying to get additional monies put into their salary schedule. A \$2000 raise would increase a support worker's monthly pay check by approximately \$150 to \$165 dollars for the remainder of their career. This increase will also increase your retirement.

Bonus checks seem good, but in reality you loose a lot of money. First, it's taxed at a higher rate than your salary, (40%). Secondly, it is for only one year. See the examples below and you do the math.

Raise in Salary

Bonus

\$150 a Month x 12 = \$1800 a year

\$2000 taxed at 40% You get \$800 only one time

Retiring in 10 years = \$18,000
