## Did You Hear... Rumors, Rumors!

### What's Real and What's Not!

Rumors are spreading across the district about pay raises, and that's what they are, **Only Rumors**. These rumors are in response to an article in the News Star on September 5, 2009. The News Star released raises that the Central office administrators had received over the past few years. The News

Star stated, "The administrative salary list shows increases in salaries during the past three years averaging \$6,704 per person for the 28 employees included." This article has upset district employees, some of whom who have worked 25 years or more and do not make those kind of salaries.

The Federation is working with Interim Superintendent Gray and the Board to find the funds necessary to give ALL support workers a salary increase. The Federation is also looking into the \$2500 MFP money that was not awarded last year to Certified Personnel. It should have been built into your salary schedule as the previous years, but it was partially given to you as a one time bonus. For those certified personnel, who said it did not affect you, think about your retirement. Your retirement is based on your 3 highest years of salary. \$2500 X 3 years = \$7500 added to your TRSL!!! The Federation will keep you posted every step of the way as we push these issues forward. You will have to do your part.
